## **Dear friends and supporters**

I am sorry this year's Newsletter is a little late but I could only make a visit to Ukraine earlier this month. This visit has allowed me to give you up to the minute news on Genesis House, so I hope you will forgive me. Ukraine is still in a state of conflict but Kiev was peaceful at the time of my visit. The City is currently busy with local elections so there will once again be many changes in local government officials, including the Mayor. This makes it difficult for us as we have to establish new relationships with the newly appointed appropriate departments.

Fortunately, we have a good history and working relationships with most of the officials so that makes things a lot easier.

## Genesis House, Ukraine

Unfortunately our family from Crimea (mentioned in our last newsletter) were not suitable as our New Foster Parents. Our aims and expectations were completely different regarding the care of children we are responsible for. They are now happily settled in the village they were born in, are safe, and well with the children healthy again after their stay at Genesis House. We all prayed very hard that the Lord would send the right couple to take over from Sasha and Olena. Our prayers were answered a few months ago when a wonderful Christian couple from our church in Kiev came forward wanting to be part of our ministry. Our new Foster Parents are Oleg and Natasha Wovk; they have two grown up children and a son Bohdan who is

eleven. They started their training with Social Services and moved into Genesis House two months ago when their training was completed. How wonderful is that? Sasha and Olena were there to help them get to know the house and help with all the paperwork for our new children. Two days before my visit our new children arrived and we have a boy, Alosha aged 12, a girl, Anya aged eight, a boy Timor aged four and a half, Twin boys, Stas and Vlad aged two and a half.

They are from one family but they had been split up and lived in different shelters for the last six months which was very traumatic especially for the little ones. Our new parents have worked hard to bring this family back together again and I saw for myself how happy and confident they were now they have all been re-united.

Our five new children all have different Fathers and lived in an apartment with their Mother and five others. The apartment comprised of one bedroom, a kitchen and a bathroom. The conditions were terrible and the children had to fend for themselves. The Social Services stepped in and the HIV positive Mother is now being stripped of her parental rights. No other Foster home was prepared to take in five children from one family. The children have all been HIV tested and are virus free and now they are safe will grow healthy and well-adjusted like all the other children who have spent time at Genesis House.

To co-incide with my visit the Social Services arranged an official re-opening of Genesis House to welcome our new Foster Parents and the new children. New Beginnings was given a special award for our work with "Children in Crisis" and commended on the example we had set within the Kiev area.



They now have 10 new Foster Homes following the example we set some 12 years ago. Many officials attended the opening from the current Deputy Mayor to the Chief Fire Officer. They along with a trio of local business men supporters brought gifts and sports equipment for the new children. This was a good example to me that we are still working in partnership with the local authorities and hopefully our relationship will grow from strength to strength. Social Services pay a small amount for each child and New Beginnings pays the wages and upkeep of the house along with the Gas bills. We have arranged for Natasha to get help from Anya, a previous employee, whilst the children are so young. Our other big expense is the

keeping running of our seventeen year old mini bus which we use to ferry the children about in. We hope to raise some funds to find a replacement.



We had our own gathering at Genesis House at the weekend during my visit and it was attended by our Foster Parents (new and retired), and our grown up young people including Yan and his adoptive parents. It was wonderful for me to see these handsome, healthy youngsters enjoying themselves and taking time to mix with the new children. It brought back memories of them arriving at Genesis House as little children from horrific backgrounds. We know that provided they work hard at their College and jobs they will have a bright future and our immediate concern is that they will be called up into the army and we worry for their safety.

Let us hold on firmly to the hope we profess, because we can trust God to keep his promise. Let us be concerned for one another, to help one another to show love and to do good. Let us not give up the habit of meeting together, as some are doing. Instead, let us encourage one another all the more, since you see that the Day of the Lord is coming nearer.

## **Great News**

The local Mayor and Council have taken over responsibility for the Borispol Rehabilitation Centre for Disabled Children and Youths. They have appointed a new head in place of Valentina, Katerina

Ivanivna is doing a fine job and when we visited all the children and one member of staff put on a concert for us.



As usual it was brilliant and we all laughed and had fun. Unfortunately the powers that be will not pay for transport for parents who have no transport but who's children desperately need the physio etc. that the centre supplies. New Beginnings have elected to fund the fuel for their minibus to transport the children and also continue to pay for the Masseur which they need especially in winter.

## Genesis Hostel, Malawi

The hostel is now virtually completed and I understand is nearly at full capacity. They still need a few more beds to complete the venture. Called Genesis Hostel at our request, it now stands on Genesis Way. The new Kitchen and dining rooms are fully functional and the hostel is able to be used out of school term time by a third party at holiday time to generate a small income to help with its upkeep.



The hostel has created five new jobs with additional staff needed. Two Ladies used to walk to the old kitchen with fruit and veg carried in baskets on their heads. Now that the Hostel is up and running, they have made enough income to be able to purchase a bicycle each and buy mattresses for their families at home to

sleep on. How fantastic is that? It has created its own little success story in being able to give a new start in life to not only the girls going to school but an income for needy families. New Beginnings has also offered for the neediest girls to fund their education by way of a bursary and scholarship.

We are so happy that for so small an outlay so many people will benefit for generations to come.
